






<p><i>R.E.</i></p> 	<p>Our RE topic for this term is about thanksgiving and harvest festival. Pupils will be learning how we say thank you or our beautiful world from a Jewish and Christian perspective. They will be learning about the creation story (Adam and Eve) and how God created the world and the order it was created.</p>
<p><i>PSHSE</i></p> 	<p>Our jigsaw theme this half term is 'All about me'. This is a lovely topic which allows teachers and their peers to get to know more about them. The topic focuses on showing the children what they like, don't like and what their family looks like and how not all families look the same.</p>
<p><i>P.E.</i></p> 	<p>Our PE focus this half term will be dance and ball skills. Within dance we will use simple movement patterns to create our own dances and share these with the rest of the class.</p>
<p><i>Music</i></p> 	<p>In music this half term we will be understanding and exploring how music is created, produced, and communicated, including through the inter-related dimensions: pitch, duration, dynamics, tempo, timbre, texture, structure and appropriate musical notations.</p>

<p><i>Geography</i></p> 	<p>Our focus this half term is about what it is like where we live. Children will be learning about the area surrounding Teagues Bridge and Trench. Children will be learning to develop knowledge about the UK and their local environment, they will use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and its grounds and the key human and physical features around them. Pupils will learn how to use simple compass directions (N, S, E, W) and locational and directional language. Pupils will be using aerial images and photographs to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features as well as using maps and keys.</p>
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### **Additional Information**

Children should be bringing in reading books and diaries every day.
