

Vision:

It is our aim:

- To have an environment where children feel safe, secure and recognise when they don't feel safe and who they can tell.
- To have a culture of openness and trust, where children feel that they can tell an adult anything.
- To develop resilience to radicalisation and all forms of grooming.
- To understand the dangers of Social Media and how this can affect their safety.
- To equip pupils with the skills to recognise when they are in an unsafe situation and how to manage it in real life situations.
- To ensure children are aware of dangerous situations in the community, at home and at school.
- To Promote diversity across the school and stamp out prejudice.

Philosophy:

Our work will be underpinned with our Magic Habits for Learning which include; Motivation, attitude, gumption, I-learn and communication. We also use JIGSAW; this integrates real life situations through PSHE and SMSC

What will the children safeguarding board do:

• Listen to all children who have a concern.

- Give advice where possible
- Resolve situations on the playground and in the classroom.
- Inform children.
- Raise children's awareness linked to the dangers in the home, school, community and wider world.
- Liaise with the headteacher
- Plan development days for all children to give them information and skills to keep safe.
